

# Killington Stage Race- Communiqué #3 After Stage 2 24 May 2015

#### **General Information:**

The following updates the information on Stage 3's award ceremony as stated on page 12 of the Tech Guide:

- The first round of awards for the Open Citizens, Men 4/5 Open, Men 4/5 Masters, Women 3/4, Men 50+ and Men 60+ will be held at **11:30am**.
- The second round of awards for the Men 3, Women 1/2/3, Men 40, and Men Pro/1/2 will be held at 1:30pm.

The white line is considered the center line for TT. Stay on shoulder unless at narrow bridge or avoiding road hazards and debris.

# **Penalties**

# Men Pro/1/2

- Rider #93 is DISQUALIFIED and fined \$100 for willful deviation of course, attempting to place without covering entire course per USAC Rules 1N4 & 8B1(c).
- Rider #91 is DISQUALIFIED for failure to cover entire course per USAC Rules 1N4.

#### Men 3

- Rider #337 The protest lodged for the fine was reviewed by the race jury and was unanimously denied.
- Riders #316, 328, 338, 352, 362 are penalized 30 seconds on General Classification for failing to sign in, 2nd offense (Tech Guide page 9).
- Rider #359 is penalized 1 minute on General Classification for centerline violations, 2nd offense (Tech Guide pg 9/USAC 3B1).

• Rider #458 is penalized 20 seconds on General Classification for taking pace or assistance from another field per Tech Guide page 9 and USAC rule 3B5.
